Villa Nueva Parking Rules and Regulations

All vehicles, whether a resident or guest vehicle, parked at Villa Nueva must display a registered <u>Villa Nueva Parking Hangtag</u> in their vehicle's front window.

- If a registered hangtag is <u>NOT</u> displayed in the vehicle, the vehicle is subject to towing at the owner's expense and the Association will not be responsible for any damage to a vehicle that has been towed.
- 1. A resident or visitor hang tag must be displayed in the vehicle even when the vehicle is parked in the unit designated covered parking space.
- 2. Towing will be at the owner or renter's expense and the Association will not be responsible for any damage to vehicles that have been towed.
- 3. All guests or visitors must park at the clubhouse and hang a registered visitor hang tag in their vehicle.
- 4. Parking is prohibited for trailers, RVs, boats, campers, and vehicles with commercial signs.

5. Residents:

- Each Unit is assigned 1 covered parking space, which is designated with their unit number on the curb stop and allocated for one of their (2) registered vehicles.
- The second vehicle should be parked in an unassigned (uncovered) parking space in the vicinity of their unit - if available.
- Each Unit will be assigned two parking hang tags and 1 Visitor hang tag.
 - Owners and Renters must register their vehicles with Ameritech.
 - Ameritech will register and provide the tags to Unit Owners or Renters when they provide their license plate number and unit number.
 - The Unit Owners who are renting their units are responsible for getting the tag(s) back when their tenant(s) move out.
 - There will be a \$20 replacement fee for any tag that needs to be replaced.
